Mode and Duration:

Conducted in English. Total 2 lessons. Each lesson lasts approx 1.5 hours with 1 intermission from 15:30 to 17:00 every Wednesday (except Public Holidays, New Year's Eve, Lunar New Year's Eve and Christmas Eve), from September 2009 to June 2010.

Equipment Requirement:

- Projector and screen for powerpoint presentation
- Mic and speakers for tutors
